




Benefits for women in entering universities

- According to the decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On the approval of the regulation on the procedure for issuing a recommendation for participation in the competition and organizing their admission to women in underprivileged families within the framework of admission indicators based on an additional state grant to higher education institutions" on June 23, 2020 there are benefits for:
- girls from low-income families in which the average monthly total income per family member does not exceed 0.527 minimum wage, or 484,000 sums;
- girls in need of social protection who are brought up in a singleparent family, that is, who have lost both parents or one of them;
- women in need of social protection, who have lost a spouse and are raising a minor child alone;
- women from needy families with children with disabilities;
- daughters of single women, raising two or more children, living separately (in rented housing) from their relatives;
- girls from needy families in which one or both parents have a disability of group I or II.
