








Types of financial and other types of support

Support for students

- Scholarships and financial support
- Free medical care (Students` polyclinics)
- Preferential food provision for low-income students (in the canteens on the territory of the institute and dormitory)
- Free exhibitions, cultural and sport events, free training courses
- Free students' dormitory and benefits in paying for rental housing (partial or full refund)
- Preferential travel by public transport (travel cards)
- Employment assistance ("Career Center" and a "Coworking Office", labor fairs etc.)
- Assistance in obtaining preferential loans for business
- Legal and psychological support etc.

Support for staff

- Stable employment contract (salary not lower than the minimum wage)
- Bonuses (for achievements, state holidays etc.), vacation pay, sick pay
- Pregnancy benefits, lump-sum payments at birth/childcare
- Vouchers to recreation centers (partial or full refund), to cultural events, events for kids, exhibitions etc.
- Medical care (polyclinics, vaccination, medical examination)
- Financial support (salary allowances)
- Financial support in learning foreign languages


